

Everyone in the room hears the message in their own language — on the phone already in their pocket.

THE SITUATION

Your congregation already speaks more languages than your service does. The Polish family. The Eritrean students. The Filipino nurses coming off a night shift. The Ukrainian mothers who arrived last year.

They come once. They smile. They don't come back — not because they weren't welcomed, but because they couldn't follow. Today you either do nothing, or someone whispers a translation from the back row, or there's a box of FM receivers in a cupboard that nobody has charged since 2019.

WHAT KOINE DOES

A QR code by the door	Someone scans it, picks their language, puts in their earbuds. Fifteen seconds. No app store, no account.
Live speech and captions in 64 languages	Listen, read, or both — and switch language mid-service without leaving.
Captions on the big screen	In the original language too, for anyone hard of hearing. Same system, no extra hardware.
Bible passages as real Bible text	In the listener's own language and translation — never a machine translation of scripture. Your operator approves each passage before it goes out.
Afterwards, nothing is lost	The service is recorded in every language that ran, with a searchable transcript. People keep their own notes and can ask questions about what they heard, cited back to the moment.

WHAT IT REPLACES

FM / IR receiver kit	\$500–2,000 transmitter, plus \$30–150 per receiver
Assistive listening station	~\$4,839 per station
A volunteer interpreter, one language	Unpaid, unreliable, and it stops when they travel
Nothing	People who visit once

SETTING IT UP

- 1

Create the event in the console — or just start it from your phone.
- 2

Choose the languages you want open. Listeners can request more; you approve or auto-accept.
- 3

Plug into the sound desk, or set a phone near the speaker. Both work.
- 4

Check the level meter, run the preflight, go live.
- 5

Print the permanent QR poster once. It works every week — the code never changes.

WHO RUNS IT

A volunteer on the sound desk — or nobody. Phone-host mode needs no computer at all.

WHO BUYS IT

The pastor, or the tech director in larger churches.

A language-hour is one language running for one hour. A 90-minute service in two languages uses 3. Listeners are always free — five people or five hundred, the price is the same. Extra hours top up and don't expire.

WHAT TO DEMO

Scan the QR yourself, in front of them, on their own service audio. What sells this is a person hearing their own preacher in a language he never spoke — not a feature list.

HONEST LIMITS

- Translation is machine translation. It is fast and it is good, and it will occasionally get a name or a doctrinal term wrong. Your operator can correct any line live and republish it. For dense theological passages, expect to correct.
- Bible text availability varies by language. We use licensed or public-domain translations where they exist, and won't machine-translate scripture.
- Voice output is a synthetic voice, not your pastor's. That is deliberate — it is what keeps the translation fast enough to follow.
- Lite and Standard currently cap at 3 languages per session.
- Everything needs working wifi or mobile data in the building.
